# Provider Post

## Emergency/Substitute Caregiver Usage

5101: 2-14-14

### **Emergency care:**

- The Provider shall contact the caretaker immediately when Emergency caregiver shall be used.
- The provider shall notify Jennifer Oliver (ext 3215) by the next working day when Emergency Caregiver was used.

### **Substitute care:**

- The Provider shall contact the caretaker prior to when Substitute Caregiver shall be used.
- The Provider shall notify Jennifer Oliver (ext 3215) prior to when Substitute Caregiver shall be used.
- The following information shall be discussed-
  - Date
  - Name of substitute caregiver
  - Location when substitute care will be provided.

**\*Failure of proper notification may result in revocation of the certification.**



## Outdoor play

5101: 2-14-17

- Be located away/protected from traffic by a fence or natural barrier.
- Be protected from animals.
- Provide access to bathroom & drinking water.
- Provide a shaded area as needed.
- Fall zone required on ground under and around the equipment.
- Sandboxes shall be covered when not in use.

## Recertification

- The agency shall renew a Type B certificate when the provider remains in compliance with Chapter 5101: 2-14.
- CCDJFS mails Type B providers a courtesy reminder letter approximately 1 month prior to recertification date. The information requested must be carefully reviewed and submitted to CCDJFS in a timely manner.
- Every 4 years at the time of the provider's recertification, CCDJFS shall request BCII fingerprints. The fingerprints shall be received and reviewed prior to recertification.



## Billing

- Providers should not bill for children in care until approval has been provided by CCDJFS.
- Please advise the clients to call and report to Barb or Lisa when **change in providers** occur.
- The child's legal name (rather than nickname) should be used on the invoice.



## Ohio Electronic Child Care (ECC)

## Rule changes to eligibility & payment



5101:2-16-35.1 entitled "Caretaker Eligibility Requirements for Publicly Funded Child Care" is a new rule containing eligibility requirements for caretakers, including limitations per child of two providers and one full-time authorization.

- Effective May 1, 2011 the caretakers can be authorized to no more than 2 providers for each child.
- CCDJFS are reviewing existing authorizations to identify caretakers who are authorized to more than two providers and will notify these caretakers that they must choose two providers for their child's care. The county will adjust the authorizations according to the change in providers made by the caretaker.

5101:2-16-41 entitled "Payment Rates for Providers of Publicly Funded Child Care" is being revised to specify dates for the use of summer school age payment rates, to define up to sixty hours as a full-time week for all providers and to add two holidays to the list of days for non-traditional hours.

- Effective May 1, CCDJFS shall pay certified type B providers a full-time rate for authorized hours of care up to 60 hours in a week.
- Effective May 1, Providers who care for children on two additional holidays, Independence Day and Martin Luther King Jr. Day, shall be paid for non-traditional hours.
