The provider must provide a safe environment when children are present.

Please take the time to properly removed snow and ice at the entrance of your home to be sure it's safely accessible.



Infants are currently enrolled in many child care homes. Please review the following regulations to be sure you are in compliance.

Infant Care

(0-18 months old)

5101: 2-14-34

- **Providers must maintain a daily written record for each infant, which is given to caretaker on a daily basis.**
(Must complete even if caretaker does not want record)
- **Infants shall be held or fed sitting up for bottle feedings.**
- **Written feeding instructions are required from caretaker.**
(Including food and/or formula)
- **Liquid in bottles shall not be heated in microwave.**
- **When preparing formula, the formula shall be prepared according to manufacturer's instructions or instructions from physician.**
(Do not add cereal into bottle unless written instructions from Dr)
- **Open containers of ready to feed & concentrated formula shall be covered, dated and refrigerated. Prepared formula shall be discarded or sent home daily if not used.**
- **All formula shall be labeled with infant's name & date of preparation.**



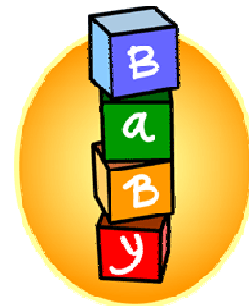
5101: 2-14-35

- **Diapers shall be checked at least every 2 hours.**
- **A disposable separation material shall be used.**
- **Soiled, disposable diapers shall be stored in a plastic lined covered container that is not easily accessible to children & discarded daily.**
- **Provider shall wash his/her hands in a sink that is not used for meal preparation and is away from the food serving area.**
(Do not wash your hands in the kitchen sink)



5101: 2-14-36

- Each infant in attendance shall be provided with a separate crib.
- Crib, play pen mattresses shall be used with the mattress support in their lowest position & crib sides in their highest positions.
- Playpen mesh openings shall be less than ¼ inch.
- Each mattress shall have a properly fitted sheet.
- Bumper pads shall not be used.
- Items shall not be placed or hung over the side that obstructs provider's visibility of infant.
- Infants shall not be placed in crib/playpen with bibs or any other items.
- Infants shall not be allowed to sleep in bassinets, swings, car seats or other equipment.
- Infants shall be placed on their backs to sleep.
- Cribs/playpens shall not be used for storage of toys and other materials.



5101: 2-14-19

- Any children's equipment having straps shall be used in accordance with manufacturer's guidelines.
(Straps shall be used in highchair, swing & other equipment)
