## Refusing home inspections

When child care children are present and care is being provided, there should never be an issue completing an inspection.

If an emergency or scheduled situation arises, the provider shall utilize an Emergency/Substitute Caregiver in which an inspection can be completed with that individual.

## Emergency/Substitute Caregivers

These individuals should be well aware of the child care regulations and the location of the provider's first aid kit, daily invoices, child's records etc.

Rule [5101:2-14-14](#): Language has been added to allow a type B provider to use an emergency/substitute caregiver as an assistant in the type B home.

(J) A type B provider may use an emergency/substitute caregiver as an assistant in the type B home.

- (1) There is no limit on the hours or days the provider may use an emergency/substitute caregiver as an assistant.
- (2) The provider shall provide a completed JFS 01920 "Emergency/Substitute Caregiver Acting as an Assistant in a Type B Professional Certified Child Care Home" (4/2011) to the CDJFS prior to using an emergency/substitute caregiver as an assistant. A copy of this form shall be maintained in the provider's files for each assistant.
- (3) The provider shall notify parents when an emergency/substitute caregiver is used as an assistant.
- (4) Use of an assistant does not change the provider's capacity.
- (5) The provider shall be present in the home or on the premises of the home when the emergency/substitute caregiver is used as an assistant.

L) As required in rule 5101:2-14-16 of the Administrative Code, the provider shall not be paid with public child care funds for caring for a child of the assistant during the time the assistant is in the provider's home.

(M) Any payment from the provider to the emergency/substitute for services provided when acting as an assistant is not a financial obligation of the CDJFS, the Ohio department of job and family services (ODJFS) or the caretaker.



## **Transportation**

While child care is being provided, the provider should keep non-childcare related activities/errands to a minimum.

Routine trip and field trip permission forms must be completed and in the child's file. Additionally, the children shall have attached to them the provider's name and phone number in an event they become lost.

## **Reimbursement Rates** (Rate change effective 7/31/11)

Ceiling Rates: Maximum reimbursement rates that the State will pay for child care services provided.

Provider's Customary Charges: Rate that the provider charges for a private pay family in care and is entered in the Provider Portal.

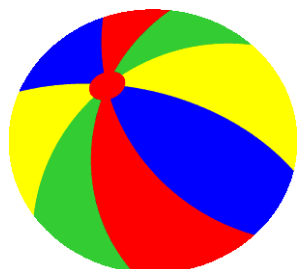
The ceiling reimbursement rates are compared to the provider's customary charges. The payment rate shall be the lower of the two.

The provider is NOT required to make changes to the information entered in the provider portal unless there is a change to the provider's private pay rates.

## **System Generated ID**

A 9 digit number was implemented for Type B providers on July 29, 2011.

The new number can be accessed through the Provider Portal.
