Swimming

- Wading pools shall be less than 2 feet in depth & must be emptied/disinfected daily.
- A swimming pool on the premises must be inaccessible and not be used by children in care.
- Approved off-site swimming pool must meet all state/local guidelines & be supervised by certified lifeguards.
- Swimming is not permitted in lakes, rivers, ponds, creeks or other similar bodies of water.
- Provider shall always accompany and closely supervise children for all water activities.



Sunscreen

- Caretaker shall complete box 1 on the JFS 01644 "Permission to Administer Medication"
- Topical product or lotion used for a preventative is valid for 12 months.



Field Trips

- Provider shall have written & signed permission from the caretaker prior to field trip.
- Written permission shall include:
 - Child's name
 - Date & destination of trip
 - Caretaker's signature
 - A statement notifying caretakers how their child will be transported.

- **The following shall be available on all trips:**
 - **Completed JFS 01297 "Child Enrollment and Health Information" for each child.**
 - **First aid kit**
 - **Completed JFS 01927 "Child's Medical/Physical Care Plan", if applicable.**
 - **Working cell phone**
- **Children shall have attached to them a telephone number & name to contact in the event that the child becomes lost.**



Incident/Injury Report

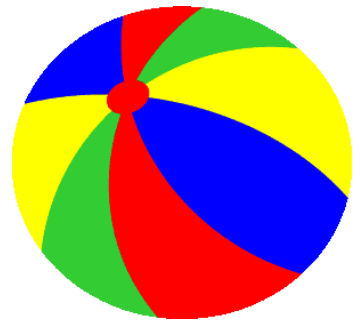
- **JFS 01299 shall be completed & copy provided to caretaker on day of incident when any of the following occur:**
 - **A child becomes ill & requires first aid**
 - **A child receives an injury which requires first aid**
 - **A child is transported to a source of emergency assistance**
 - **A child receives a bump/blow to the head**
 - **An unusual or unexpected incident, which jeopardizes the safety of a child or provider.**
- **The provider shall notify the CDJFS within 24 hours in the event of any of the following:**
 - **Death of a child at the home**
 - **Serious incident, injury or illness to a child**
 - **An unusual or unexpected incident**



Outdoor Play

- Shall be provided each day in suitable weather for any toddler, preschool and school child in attendance 4 or more consecutive daylight hours.
- School age children may be permitted outdoors without the provider as long as the children remain within sight/hearing & are not engaged in higher risk activities.
