Hand washing

Supplies Needed:

Liquid soap

Running water

Individually assigned towels or disposable toweling

Provider shall wash their hands for 15 seconds:

After toileting or assisting a child with toileting

After changing diaper or pull-up

After contact with bodily fluids

After taking off disposable gloves

After cleaning/sanitizing or using any chemical products

After handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects

Before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child

Before and after administering medication

The child shall be instructed and assisted as needed to wash their hands:

After toileting

After contact with bodily fluids

After returning inside from outside play

After handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects

Before eating or assisting with food preparation

Wash, Wash, Wash Your Hands (*Tune of Row, Row, Row Your Boat*)

Wash, wash, wash your hands

Wash them nice and clean.

Wash them on top, wash them on bottom and fingers in between.
