

## Changes to Medicaid:

### Extending Medicaid to more low-income Ohioans for coverage

beginning January 1, 2014.

#### Who is newly eligible for Medicaid coverage?

- Beginning January 1, 2014, an additional group of residents – also referred to as Group 8 – will become eligible for Medicaid coverage in Ohio.
- Group 8: This group includes adults between the ages of 19 to 64, who are between 0 – 138% FPL\* and are not eligible under another category of Medicaid.
- Parents: Parents living with their minor children between 0-90% FPL are currently eligible for Medicaid coverage. **NEW:** Parents 91-138% FPL are now eligible as Group 8 adults. Adults without children are now eligible as Group 8 adults.
